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God's Will

“And if it seem evil unto you to serve the Lord, choose you this day whom ye will serve; whether the gods which your fathers served that were on the other side of the flood, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land ye dwell: but as for me and my house we will serve the Lord. And the people answered and said, God forbid that we should forsake the Lord, to serve other gods; for the Lord our God, He it is that brought us up and our fathers out of the land of Egypt, from the house of bondage, and which did those great signs in all the way wherein we went, and among all the people through whom we passed: and the Lord drove out from before us all the people, even the Amorites which dwelt in the land: therefore will we also serve the Lord: for He is an Holy God; He is a jealous God; He will not forgive your transgressions nor your sins. If ye forsake the Lord, and serve strange gods, then He will turn and do you hurt, and consume you, after that He hath done you good. And the people said unto Joshua, nay; but we will serve the Lord. And Joshua said unto the people, ye are witnesses. Now therefore put away, said he, the strange gods which are among you, and incline your heart unto the Lord God of Israel. And the people said unto Joshua, the Lord our God will we serve, and His voice will we obey.”
Joshua 34:15-24.

Is there a ‘God’s will’? Do you believe, if there is, you are in it? Just how do you feel? Have you thought about it lately? Do you know what it is? Good questions to know the answers to, aren’t they? Are you interested in knowing? Look at the first statement. ‘*And if it seem evil unto you to serve the Lord*’, evil compared to what? Evil that you serve the Lord, or is it too hard to make a decision to serve Him? What is your reason or excuse? Why is it evil, to do something you know you are not supposed to do, in your eyes and mind? Is this what is evil for you, can’t give up the worldly things? Is it worth eternal joy for a few worldly things and ways?

Are you still serving the gods as it says, before the great flood or the gods in this land you live in? **GOD FORBID!** The god's people served before the flood only brought God's wrath upon the people. Death by drowning! Do you know who the god of this world is? The god of this world is Satan, Lucifer, or the devil, which ever you prefer to call him. I call him a looser, a cheat, a liar, a murderer, and a foe to contend with. Be aware of his lies and dealings, do not be deceived! Follow the Lord God and be not deceived or lied to as Joshua said, '*But as for me and my house we will serve the Lord.*' Can you really state, '*as for as my house we ...*' can you say truthfully *we* will serve the Lord'? **YES!!!** Yes you can. Take control of your house, your kids do not, I say again, **do not control the house and family.** Parents or parent, it is your responsibility and obligation to God to run your household and **take** your kids to church and to God, it is your reasonable service and there blood is on your hands. Be what God put you in charge of! You have charge of them until they don't live in your household any longer or out of your support.

The two million or so children of Israel said, God forbid, if we serve other gods. They didn't witness all the miracles and deliverances to get us out of bondage in Egypt. If all said this, why did Joshua tell them to choose you this day who you will serve? He was just exhorting them or urging them to keep fearing the Lord and serve Him in sincerity and truth, stay alert to the dangers of Satan, Lucifer. We can not be urged enough to be aware and smart to his lies.

God told these children and tells us today, that, just because I am a Holy God and I am a jealous God, that I drove away all enemies, fought battles, fed and nourished you, brought you out of bondage, to not turn from Me or forsake Me or I will turn and hurt you, I will do this even after I have done all the good things for you. **GOT THE POINT? GOD IS SERIOUS AND REALLY CARES FOR HIS CHILDREN, YOU, YOU, YOU!!!!** When you make a choice to serve Him, you are your own witness or judge to do what is Godly and to serve Him. No one else is liable, but yourself, if you fail and not serve Him, but the other gods around you, no one else is going to hell except you for your unrepented sins.

So, choose you this day who you will serve, if you don't choose Him ever, then you will go to hell and if you choose Him and fail or fall, you will also go to hell for your unrepented sins. **REPENTANCE** is a must for anyone! Your goal, then should be, choose Him and stay in God's will. **REPENTANCE** is a must for everyone! **REPENTANCE** is a vow to God that you want forgiveness of your sins and that you will not do this sin anymore; if broken, it becomes a lie. "*Know ye not, that to whom yield yourselves servants to obey, his servants ye are to whom ye obey; whether of sin unto death, or of obedience unto righteousness.*" Romans 6:16. And "*Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;*" 2 Corinthians 10:5, So choose, we are urged, exhorted, prodded, pleaded with, implored, begged and recommend that we, "*Elect according to the foreknowledge of God the Father, through sanctification of the Spirit, unto obedience and sprinkling of the blood of Jesus Christ:*" 1 Peter 1:2. We are to choose this day whom we will serve and serve Him as no other before. **GOD'S WILL ... OBEDIENCE TO HIM** and to no others.

Do you now believe, has it made a difference? Do you now know that God expects obedience, no off and on or on and off love for Him? Jesus says in Revelation 3:15,16, "*I know thy works, that thou art neither cold nor hot: I would thou wert cold or hot. So then because thou art lukewarm, and neither cold nor hot, I will spew thee out of My mouth.*" Do not wait until, Jesus says, "... *depart from Me, ye cursed into everlasting fire, prepared for the devil and his angels:*" Matthew 25:41 or "*And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from Me, ye that work iniquity.*" Matthew 7:23. Is Jesus lying when He said these things, that He will tell him that He never knew him? **NO**, Jesus never lies, He is the only One that will not, the only righteous One, the only sinless One ever. Only to those that work iniquity, read it all. Jesus God can't look upon sin, so if you are sinning He does not know you, so He is not lying when He tells them He does not know them, He does not know them, in sin.

Now, how do you feel? Do you feel He has spewed you out of His mouth or do you feel blessed for your obedience? Do you want to get out of your iniquities? Then repeat after me, Father, I'm a sinner. Lord God forgive me of my sins. I repent and desire to be renewed in Spirit and in Truth. Father, change me! I believe You, Jesus, You are the Son of God and that You did die for me and defeated death and the grave for me in Your resurrection. Father I believe! Amen.
